## 3) Executive Summary

#### The London Regional Cytology Training Centre ran:-

- Fourteen pre-registration courses
- Twelve post-registration courses
- Six medical courses (including ST1 course, Medics/AP one day update, and two pathologists courses covering gynae & non-gynae topics)
- Nine smear takers course
- One HBPC Update course
- Grand total of 410 persons underwent training in 2011/12
- All courses except one were rated as "highly relevant" from anonymous student feedback.
- We have developed an LRCTC formal user group for NHS London, of service
- providers. They have given excellent feedback and input into the roll out of our courses and future development.
- The LRCTC has maintained its good working relationship with NHS London and London QARC.
- New initiatives: A new course management system has been introduced which will help us in our diversification with other healthcare professional groups training strategy, we have published our first e-learning module for primary care practice nurses and GP's on HPV Triage implementation which will train these groups prior to roll out of the new HPV test for women in 2012.

## 4) Introduction

The London Regional Cytology Training Centre, hosted at North West London Hospitals NHS Trust, was originally founded in 1979; it has a national and international profile for high-quality cervical and non-cervical / diagnostic cytopathology training. Due to the current demand for a wide range of cancer screening training for many healthcare professional groups, we have diversified into other training activities which make maximum use of our expertise and facilities to meet this demand for other healthcare professional groups.

## 5) Pre-registration Programmes

This year has seen a slight drop in numbers for the two year NHSCSP accredited City & Guilds Diploma for non-medical trainees. Training of C&G assessors from individual laboratories has continued with the certificated training course which aims to familiarise assessors with all aspects of the portfolio work carried out in the work place. To date eleven trainees have passed the Diploma this year.

#### i) Introductory course

This is a four week intensive course, attended within the first 6 months of employment, and after learners has spent a minimum of 6 weeks in the home laboratory. We ran one course over the year on, 1<sup>st</sup> -30<sup>th</sup> March 2012 with 7 students.

#### ii) Follow-up Course

This is a one week course attended by learners in their second year and designed to re-enforce cytological principles outlined in the introductory course. We ran two courses in this period on  $1^{st} - 5^{th}$  August 2010 with 5 students and  $9^{th}$  -  $13^{th}$  January 2012 with 3 students.

#### iii) Pre-exam course

This is a one week revision course focusing on examination technique to candidates sitting their City and Guilds Diploma. Two courses were run over the year on  $9^{th} - 13^{th}$  May 2011 with 9 students and  $28^{th}$  November  $-2^{rd}$  December 2011 with 5 students.

#### iv) Monthly Tuition Days

The LRCTC runs monthly "tuition days" for all trainees, this is a single day/month whereby trainees attend the LRCTC for topic-related workshops. It supplements and enhances the introductory and follow-up courses. It allows the LRCTC staff to maintain their contact with trainees and improve monitoring of students' progress. These days have proved popular with good attendance by all trainees in the system. Eight tuition days were held with a total 47 students attending.

#### v) Host Laboratory Visits

After completion of the Introductory Course a written report is prepared and a member of staff from the LRCTC visits the trainee's laboratory to present the report to the trainee, training assessor, and laboratory manager. The meeting is designed as a positive feedback mechanism and enables all parties to discuss and sign up to a formal individual training plan whilst discussing the requirements for the portfolio and assignments that will have to be carried out within the department. 10 laboratory visits were carried out.

#### vi) Training Officer Meetings

NHSCSP requirements are for two meetings a year (28<sup>th</sup> April 2011 & 30<sup>th</sup> June 2011) to gain user group feedback from laboratories on our courses and service requirements as well as to keep them updated on current issues. We have now established an NHS Service Providers group which links into our comprehensive performance indicator contract which ensures that all courses are relevant to London Service Providers. This group met on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 2011 which looked at and reviewed course content, qualifications and general employer requirements. This is part of our annual review and adds to the data required for the NHS London Performance Indicator Contract. All outcome results are fed back electronically after they have been issued and discussed at the NHS London Annual General Review Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2012.

#### vii) Examination Centre for Diploma in Cervical Cytology

This centre is one of the national examination venues for NHSCSP City and Guilds Diploma This underscores the high quality facilities and the excellent reputation of the LRCTC staff who administer the exams. The latest examination was held here on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2012 – eighteen candidates from around the UK sat the examination.

#### viii) Introductory Course for Medical Laboratory Assistants

This course was developed in collaboration with our NHS London Service Provider User Group who felt there was a need for MLA's to have some form of formal training and updating. We ran very successful courses last year 27<sup>th</sup> April 2011 with 9 students attending and the second course on the 27<sup>th</sup> October 2011 with 9 students attending.

Feedback from both the NHSL User group and student questionnaires was excellent.

## 6) Qualified Staff CPD Programmes

#### i) Update Courses for BMS/Cytoscreeners

Every qualified cytoscreener and biomedical scientist must attend as part of NHSCSP continued professional development a tri-annual 3 day cervical cytology Update course at an accredited cytology training centre. The LRCTC ran seven three-day update courses in this period on,  $19^{th} - 21^{st}$  April 2011 with 12 students,  $6^{th} - 8^{th}$  June 2011 with 13 students,  $21^{st} - 23^{rd}$  September 2011 with 15 students,  $7^{th} - 9^{th}$  November 2011 with 15 students,  $21st - 23^{rd}$  November 2011 with 16 students  $12th - 14^{th}$  December 2011 with 15 students,  $16^{th} - 18^{th}$  January 2012 with 13 students and  $13^{th} - 15^{th}$  February 2012 with 15 students.

This modular three day update course is regularly re-populated with current topic related slides and in addition completely re-vamped every three years at the start of each new Update cycle. 2011 marked the beginning of a new Update course content cycle with brand new topics, lectures and workshops.

## ii) City & Guilds Assessor training

Our deputy training centre manager has led on the design of a new national courses for all qualified training assessors. This course is designed to fully equip the assessors to plan, feedback, and review and mark their Learners City & Guilds portfolio assignments.

One course was held this year with 4 assessors attending and gaining certification.

#### iii) External Quality Assurance Programme for Cervical Cytology (EQA)

The LRCTC is host to representatives from London Regional QARC to assess slides for inclusion in the mandatory regional EQA programmes. Use of the LRCTC's state-of-the-art multiheaded microscope is essential for this programme. The training centre was used as a resource for five days this year on the national quality programme.

#### iv) Technical External Quality Assurance TEQA

The LRCTC hosts a tri-monthly two day Technical EQA workshop for the London Region which is facilitated by the high-class facilities and on hand expertise of staff. The LRCTC hosts the annual London Region TEQA meeting for London regional representatives to give feedback on slide-staining quality issues and is mandatory for a quality assured cervical screening programme. The training centre was used as a resource for ten days on this national quality programme

#### v) Pathologists course

The LRCTC, since its inception in 1979, has always run a Pathologists course aimed primarily at trainee pathologists about to sit their MRCPath examination. This is a highly successful five day course covering gynae and non-gynae samples. Due to demand we have increased the course frequency from one to two courses per annum. This course was run on,  $12^{th} - 16^{th}$  September 2011 with 7 students. Due to the recent changes in the Royal College of Pathologists training syllabus we have changed our pathologists course as of January 2012 and divided into a one week non-gynaecological cytology course with optional exam component and a three day gynaecological course with an optional exam component. The revamped course ran on the  $6^{th} - 10^{th}$  February 2012 with 15 students and the three day gynae cytology course held on the  $27^{th}$ -  $29^{th}$  February 2012 with 6 students.

#### vi) Medical Specialist Trainees course

The LRCTC runs a five day basic gynaecological cytology course for London Regional ST's, which is contracted by the London Deanery as part of their specialist pathology training. This was held on the 31<sup>st</sup> October – 4<sup>th</sup> November 2011 with 18 students attending.

#### vii) One Day Gynae Update for Consultants and AP staff:

A one day update for consultant pathologists and advanced practitioner biomedical scientists has been developed since 2008, and aims to maintain their continued professional development in cervical cytology. Two courses were run in 2011/12 on 24<sup>th</sup> May 2011 with 9 students and 17<sup>th</sup> November 2011 with 9 students.

## 7) Additional Courses developed in partnership with NHS London

#### i) HBPC Update Course

This is a one-day update for all Hospital Based Programme Coordinators staff working in cervical cytology screening. This is a course designed as an update.

This was held on the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2011 with 19 in attendance.

#### ii) Non-gynae training for BMS staff

The LRCTC has enhanced its non-gynae cytology training portfolio for BMS to support the introduction of the IBMS Diploma in Expert Practice in Non-Gynaecologic Cytology.

Brand new courses introduced in 2008 include two day respiratory, fluid and urine cytology training. This training will be a key component in supporting BMS staff not only for CPD but in career progression.

Courses held on the  $16^{th}$  –  $17^{th}$  June 2011 with 9 students,  $1^{st}$ - $2^{nd}$  September 2011 with 12 students and  $14^{th}$  –  $15^{th}$  November 2011 with 12 students.

#### iii) Cervical Smear Sample Takers Foundation Courses

This is an innovative two day introductory course run by LRCTC for its three host PCT's, for all new cervical sample takers. Crucially it has allowed us to develop for the first time a current and flexible database of all new sample takers, including the issuing of a unique individual registration numbers.

Two courses were run in 2011/12 the first on 15<sup>th</sup> July & 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2011 with 10 students and the second being run on 16<sup>th</sup> & 23<sup>th</sup> February 2011 with 31 students.

#### iv) Cervical Smear Sample Takers Update Courses

In conjunction with the three local PCT's our administrator manages a comprehensive database of all qualified smear taker staff which is regularly updated, this allows us to schedule Update courses. The Update cervical smear taker's courses for the region ensure all clinical staff taking cervical smears maintain their certification by regular triennial updates as part of their continuing professional development in practice. Five courses were run in the 2011/12 period on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2011 with 20 students, 14<sup>th</sup> June 2011 with 11 students, and 31st August 2011 with 6 students and two courses on the 8<sup>th</sup> December 2011 with 13 students.

#### v) NHS Service Provider Meeting:

As part of our new Performance Indicator Contract we have set up the London NHS Service Providers group which will undertake to discuss annual reports and confirm action plans, agree training course requirements and employer's needs, this will work in partnership with the HEI/TEP and NHS London. The meeting was held on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 2011 and was well attended with 13 Representatives from as many trusts around London. All outcome results are fed back electronically after they have been issued and discussed at the NHS London Annual General Review Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> February 2012.

#### vi) Distance Learning

The LRCTC has a dedicated website (<u>www.lrctc.org.uk</u>) which includes educational packages for CPD and distance learning.

We have introduced a web-based marking scheme for relevant courses where students need to review slides at their host laboratory site but are "virtually" marked and graded by us at the LRCTC.


We have now set up a Course Management System called Moodle; this provides us with a powerful platform in which to publish e-learning modules from.

The first e-learning module was published on the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2012 to cater for the changes revolving around the introduction of HPV testing as a triage for low grade cytological abnormality management. The module was specifically targeted at primary care sample takers and has been taken up by many sectors in London. To date around 600 persons have undertaken the module.

## 8) Course feedback

All courses held in 2011/12 except one were rated as "highly relevant" to student's needs and work place requirements. These figures are based on anonymous feedback from participants on each course

# i) Appendix 1: NHS London Contract Performance Indicators (CPI's) 010/11 (Current)

Our "annual report" for NHS London has evolved since 2009. This is part of our Performance Indicator Contract in which we receive RAG ratings on our performance each academic yearly cycle.

We received a Performance Rating of 89.7% with a RAG rating of High Amber. Our overall rating was Green with a score for High Amber on one criteria **C2b Collection** of **NHS Organisation feedback**. Key areas:

- Feedback is: "A suggestion for next year would be to add an agenda item to the NHS user group meetings to facilitate feedback and report on improvements being made".
- We have signed up to an action plan for 11/12 to outline the root cause and set in place actions to remedy this administrative error.
